

Affidavit Review Guide

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Topic

A short guide for suv'erans who wish to review Affidavits

General Background

As of 30 June 2025, the majority, if not all, of the data and structural/paragraph issues in the Albion Affidavit have been resolved. Ongoing Affidavit reviews will undoubtedly identify minor issues (e.g., typos), which will be corrected directly in the Affidavit by the Albion Glue associates.

Affidavit Review Guidelines

General

If all suv'erans follow all the Affidavit guidelines, then Affidavit reviews should be light touch, spending no more than approximately two hours covering the basic points below. Affidavit reviews are a great way to deepen your knowledge of the Affidavit content and process and to build strong relationships and trust with other suv'erans.

It is recommended for suv'erans who wish to have their Affidavit reviewed to buddy up with another Albion suv'eran or a group of Albion suv'erans to complete and review their Affidavits together. The other option is to request a suv'eran volunteer who has completed their Affidavit to review the Affidavit. Requests can be done via the following:

Important: Do not send your Affidavit for review to contact@peoplescourt.co.uk. Only a few Albion Glue suv'erans support this support email to answer general queries only and not to review Affidavits.

Generally, you do not edit the suv'eran's Affidavit - you simply add review comments directly in the Affidavit.

Out of Scope

1. Government/Agencies/Corporations and respective D-U-N-S Numbers
2. Family names - given names and bloodline names
3. Affidavit data updates from previous versions
4. Spell check - should be conducted by the suv'eran
5. Additional content added to the Affidavit by the suv'eran

In Scope

1. Suv'eran to provide the Affidavit for review with red text displayed. Easier to review.
2. General Affidavit layout.
 - a. Check the Flag is not too close to the top left-hand corner of the page (approx. 1.5 cm from the top edge and left edge of the page)
 - b. Check the Photo is not too close to the top right-hand corner of the page (approx. 2.0 cm from the top edge and 1.5 cm from the right edge of the page).
 - c. Quickly scan the document with your eyes for unusual items that look out of place, e.g. incomplete paragraphs, missing bullet points, unusual spaces between words and paragraphs, etc
3. Flag Rules on Paper - Everything below the top of your flag represents your truth on paper. Ensure that all content, including the passport photo, is positioned below the top of your flag.
4. Flags - IMPORTANT - DO NOT USE other Country/Corporation flags when the suv'eran creates their Flag design. Breach of copyright and suv'eran will come under the country's jurisdiction if they use another country's flag.
5. Paragraph numbering—Ensure that paragraph numbering is consistent throughout the Affidavit. Click on the first paragraph number, which should highlight the paragraph numbering structure. Go to the end of the document, approximately paragraph 208, to see the same structure highlighted.

6. No square brackets should be used within the Affidavit. Any text within square brackets is considered to be off the page or document. The only exception to this is in the context of Postcodes, where square brackets are ok to use. You live in your body, not at a Postcode.
7. No boxes or checkboxes should be used in the Affidavit - any text in a box is deemed off the page/document.
8. No underlines on the Affidavit (including the main autograph page) - any text underlined is deemed off the page/document.
9. General rule of thumb: anything in double quotes refers to their fictional system. For example, an Affidavit, birth certificate, name, bloodline, Town/City, Government, Corporation, estate name, Year, Military Title (e.g., Mr, Mrs, Miss), and Postcode.
10. Single quotes used for the Soul name, Living given names, The People's Court of Terra Australis, The People's Court of Albion, PC-LS-xxxx, PC-FN-xxxx and Statement and Asseveration of Truth.
11. No Quotes are required for factual land - e.g. Albion, Scotia, Cymru.
12. Ensure the date of the Affidavit relates to the date on which the suv'eran has the Affidavit witnessed or notarised. Either edit the date directly in the Affidavit or leave the date blank and manually write the date in words when you get your Affidavit witnessed or notarised. Dates are mentioned on page 1 of the Affidavit and in paragraph 208 (approximately).
13. Living wo/man - ensure the correct gender is used for the suv'eran. The latest Affidavit has comments on paragraph #60 (him/her).
14. Blood type - paragraph #21. If the suv'eran does not know this, they can delete the text.
15. Paragraph #62 - the use of "surname". Australian case law applies to the United Kingdom. No need to change this paragraph. The full court of the Family Court of Australia should NOT be changed.
16. Ensure the same PC-LS-xxxx number is used in paragraphs #33 and #126 (conveyance identification plates).
17. Ensure the Affidavit refers to the correct document, the Universal Declaration of Human Rights (paragraphs #84 and #122), and not to other documents that do not exist (e.g. Universal Proclamation of Human Rights or Universal Asseveration of Human Rights).
18. Paragraph #125. Comment added to the latest Affidavit. In the context of travelling, it's simpler for suv'erans to use Albion, even if they reside in Scotia or Cymru.
19. Ensure the Address at the beginning of the Affidavit agrees with the Address in paragraph #189.
20. Ensure the Affidavit footer page number (last page) is refreshed, e.g. from 41 of 42 to 42 of 42, etc.
21. Delete the Albion Affidavit Change log and The People's Lore of Albion Legal Disclaimer at the end of the Affidavit before finalising the Affidavit for witnessing.
